

This panoramic ten-day sojourn winds its way from Pretoria to Cape Town and includes a golfing and non-golfing itinerary. After a game drive in the famous Kruger Park, guests head to Swaziland for game viewing at Mkhaya Reserve. The train then travels the coast along St Lucia Wetland Park to Durban for a city tour and through the Valley of a Thousand Hills. Enjoy a tour of battlefields then continue overnight along the imposing Drakensberg Mountains to Port Elizabeth for Addo Elephant Park. Then it's on to Oudtshoorn for an ostrich-farm visit followed by an impressive rail descent through the Outeniqua Mountains to George. After visiting the natural paradise of Knysna, the train traverses the spectacular Garden Route across the Cape Fold Mountains before this magnificent expedition ends in Cape Town. Golfers play Leopard Creek at Kruger, Durban Country Club, Humewood in Port Elizabeth, Champagne Sport Resort in Ladysmith, Fancourt in Knysna & Ernie Els Oubaai in George. Available in reverse.

Itinerary

Day 1 - Depart Pretoria

9:00 am Check-in at Rovos Rail Station in Pretoria for departure at 10:00 am. Lunch and dinner are served as the train travels east towards Mpumalanga. (Breakfast 7:00-10:00 am • Lunch 1:00 pm • Tea 4:30 pm • Dinner 7:30 pm)

Day 2 - Leopard Creek or Kruger Park

Golfers: 9:00 am Tee off at Leopard Creek near Kruger with lunch. Non-golfers: 6:00 am Game drive in the Kruger Park with lunch. 5:00 pm Rejoin the train at Malelane and depart for Swaziland.

Day 3 - Mkhaya Reserve

6:00am Game drive in the Mkhaya Reserve in Swaziland with tea. 10:30am Lunch is served as the train travels south alongside the St. Lucia Wetland Park to Durban for the overnight stop.

Dav 4 - Durban

Golfers: 8:00 am Tee off at Durban Country Club/Beachwood/Zimbali. Non-golfers: 8:00 am Disembark for a short city tour of Durban. 4:00 pm Traverse the Valley of a Thousand Hills to Ladysmith.

Day 5 - Champagne Sports Resort

Transfer to Champagne Sports Resort for a morning tee off. Non-golfers: 10:00 am Spionkop battlefields tour, game drive and lunch. 5:00 pm Travel to Kroonstad across the Drakensberg Mountains.

Day 6 - Aboard *Rovos Rail*

Enjoy a day of leisure as the train travels toward the coast.

Day 7- Humewood Course or Addo Elephant Park

Golfers: Morning tee off at Humewood Course. Enjoy a game and lunch before joining the train in Port Elizabeth. Non-golfers: 7:30 am Game drive at Addo Elephant Park. 12:00 pm Rejoin the train and depart for Willowmore.

Day 8 - Fancourt or Oudtshoorn

Golfers: Transfer to Fancourt along Montagu Pass for a morning tee off. 16:30 pm meet your fellow travelers for a dinner at the estate. Non-golfers: 9:00 am Two-hour ostrich-farm visit. Traverse the Montagu Pass to George. 6:30 pm Disembark for dinner at Fancourt Estate.

Day 9 - Ernie Els Oubaai or Featherbed

Golfers: Morning tee off at Ernie Els Oubaai. Non-golfers: 8:00 am Morning at leisure in Knysna or ferry ride to Featherbed. 1:30 pm Depart George and travel along the Garden Route via the Outeniqua Mountains to the coast for Riversdale.

Day 10 - Tour Conclusion

Enjoy a day of leisure traversing the Cape Fold Mountains. 5:00 pm Arrive at Platform 23 at Cape Town Station.

Train and Hotel Accommodations

Pullman Suites FROM NZ\$7,190 per person twin/double share
